

# AFL South East Match Day Report AFLSE Juniors & FDJ/SEJ

### Reportable Incident

- Stop Play
- Clear player/s away from incident
- Only player/s involved are to remain.
- Seek assistance from other umpires to assist if needed.
- Advise player/s if they have been reported and what for.
- Inform reported player/s what card (YELLOW/RED) they are being sent off on.
- Raise YELLOW/RED/BLUE card in the air so the TIME KEEPERS & TEAM MANAGERS are aware of what card the player/s are being sent off on and how long they are expected to spend on the sidelines.
- Player/s are to leave the playing field.
- A Yellow Card requires the player to be ordered off for 15 minutes of actual playing time and cannot be replaced during that time.
- A Red Card requires the player to be ordered off for the remainder of the match and can be replaced after 20 minutes of **actual playing time**.
- A Blue Card requires the player to be ordered off for 15 minutes of actual playing time but can be replaced during that time
- The game is not to resume until the umpire making the report has collected all information they require.
- A YELLOW/BLUE card can be issued without report
