

AFL South East Match Day Report

AFLSE Juniors & FDJ/SEJ

Reportable Incident

- Stop Play
- Clear player/s away from incident
- Only player/s involved are to remain.
- Seek assistance from other umpires to assist if needed.
- Advise player/s if they have been reported and what for.
- Inform reported player/s what card (YELLOW/RED) they are being sent off on.
- Raise YELLOW/RED/BLE card in the air so the TIME KEEPERS & TEAM MANAGERS are aware of what card the player/s are being sent off on and how long they are expected to spend on the sidelines.
- Player/s are to leave the playing field.
- A Yellow Card requires the player to be ordered off for 15 minutes of **actual playing time** and **cannot be replaced during that time**.
- A Red Card requires the player to be ordered off for the remainder of the match and can be replaced after 20 minutes of **actual playing time**.
- A Blue Card requires the player to be ordered off for 15 minutes of **actual playing time** but **can be replaced during that time**
- The game is not to resume until the umpire making the report has collected all information they require.
- A YELLOW/BLUE card can be issued without report

Impact Guidelines	
Low	Player: Minimal or no impact on the Match - the Player continued to play the majority of the Match and suffered no or minimal ongoing issues. Person (other than Player): Person continued in their relevant capacity in relation to the Match for the majority of the Match and suffered no or minimal ongoing issues
Medium	Player: Clearly some impact on the Player, and/or the Player left the field for a lengthy period of time, and/or some possible lower level ongoing treatment(s) required. Person (other than Player): Clearly some impact on the Person, and/or the Person was prevented from continuing in their official capacity in relation to the Match for a lengthy period of time, and/or some possible lower level ongoing treatment(s) required.
High	Player: Major impact on the Player, and/or the Player was unable to participate in the remainder of the Match, and/or major ongoing issues that require medical intervention and/or may miss some Matches. Person (other than Player): Major impact on the Person, and/or the Person was unable to continue in their official capacity in relation to the Match for the remainder of the Match, and/or major ongoing issues that require medical intervention and/or may miss some Matches
Severe	Person (including Player): Major impact and serious injury to the Person, and/or likely to miss a significant number of Matches.
