Holding the Ball – diving on the ball.

Last week we spoke about players diving on the ball. Generally we see an increase in this tendency in wet weather. I was very pleased to see how we adapted last weekend and paid a number of correct holding the ball decisions against players who dived on the ball or dragged the ball back in and did not immediately dispose of it. 1. Correct Holding the ball (fend) paid by Dakota. Note how he gets in to manage the situation given there are two players on the ground.

3. Correct insufficient intent paid by Sam – goes direct to the line and no players in the vicinity. Excellent support provided by Jarryd at set kick.
