1. HTB – Prior Opportunity

What are the 7 cues / actions that must occur for the play to be considered a prior opportunity?

1. HTB – Prior Opportunity

- Evade
- Fend
- A prior option to dispose
- Balanced and steady
- Has taken a mark/FK been awarded
- Drives head
- Ducks head

What are the key elements that must be in play for this type of free kick?



2. HTB – Incorrect Disposal

What are the key elements that must be in play for this type of free kick?

- Legal tackle
- No prior opportunity
- Ball is not correctly disposed of

* If a ball is knocked out in the tackle and there has been no prior opportunity, what do we do?



3. HTB – No Genuine Attempt

- Player has no prior opportunity prior to being tackled.
- Tackled player is able to and does not make a genuine attempt to dispose.
- A reasonable time is provided.

*As umpires, what must we ensure we do in these circumstances?

4. HTB – Dive on the ball

 If a player elects to dive on/drag the ball underneath the body and is tackled legally by an opposition player a free kick shall be paid.

*If the player elects to stand up after dragging the ball in and is tackled legally, what is the decision? * In this instance, does a player need to have had prior?
